What is Brazil's first large-scale energy storage system?

Brazil launched on Thursday its first large-scale energy storage system with a total capacity of 30 MW, power sector regulator Aneel announced.

What is Brazil's largest battery storage project?

Further details about Brazil's largest battery storage project to date have been revealed including its integrators and equipment providers. The inauguration of the 30MW/60MWh system took place last year, on the networks of transmission system operator (TSO) ISO CTEEP, as reported by Energy-Storage.news in November.

"One way to expand the share of renewable sources in Brazil's power generation mix is by giving them greater predictability. A non-dispatchable, non-predictable renewable source, when combined with a storage system, becomes dispatchable, that is, more widely used by the national system operator.

The Brazilian electricity market is changing as the country expands the generation of weather-dependent renewable energy based on wind and solar power. At the same time, electricity consumption is set to increase significantly in the coming years.

The project will be Brazil's largest battery energy storage system and is a significant step for the country's power market. Though a clean energy pioneer with nearly 20GW of commissioned wind and solar capacity, Brazil's energy storage market is virtually non-existent, hamstrung by high import taxes and a lack of supportive policy.

Secretary of Energy of the United States Jennifer Granholm and the Federative Republic of Brazil's Minister of Mines and Energy, Alexandre Silveira announced new, joint initiatives on clean energy and renewed their commitment to advance a just and inclusive energy transition today at the third ministerial meeting of the U.S.-Brazil Energy Forum (USBEF).

ISO CTEEP claimed it as the first large-scale battery energy storage system (BESS) on Brazil's transmission grid. The project required a total US\$27 million investment. The transmission operator is permitted by regulations to earn up to US\$5 million revenues from the ...

Brazil leads Latin America in renewable energy, with hydropower accounting for 55%, wind energy at 15%, and solar at 6%. In the past five years, the country's wind energy capacity has doubled, growing from 13,240 MW in 2018 to 27,529 MW in 2023.

From this perspective, Brazil's energy and electricity matrices are constantly gaining strength; as an example, in July 2023, Brazil has reached the goal of 23 GW of capacity only from consumers who generate their own energy from photovoltaic plants: the distributed mini and microgeneration.

The Residential Energy Storage market in Brazil encounters challenges stemming from the initial high costs of energy storage systems and limited awareness among consumers. Despite the potential benefits of increased energy independence and resilience, convincing homeowners to invest in these systems remains a hurdle.

In view of these new technologies, this study aims to analyze Brazil's current regulatory framework for the evaluation and certification of oil and mineral reserves and possible energy (natural gas, hydrogen, and compressed air) and non-energy (carbon dioxide) storage in depleted oil reservoirs.
