

# Cook islands energy storage project

ESB Networks has announced that Ireland's electricity grid now has 1GW of energy storage available from different energy storage assets. This figure includes 731.5MW of battery energy storage system (BESS) projects and 292MW from Turlough Hill pumped storage power station - which is celebrating its 50th anniversary this year.

This is the largest storage portfolio under construction in Mississippi, and Origis expects to commission all three projects next year. The goal of the program is to deliver solar renewable energy to all five of the Southern Cook Islands by 2020. Under this \$24.28 million project, each of the solar power plants built on the southern islands will have a total capacity of around 3 MW.

Infratec Chief Executive Greg Visser said the four solar plants were now providing clean, reliable and affordable energy to almost 1500 people - or about 9 percent of the Cook Islands' population. The solar panels, which are backed by battery storage, will meet about 95 percent of the islands' energy needs, he said.
