Are Storage Containers and Shipping Containers Different Sizes? The terms "storage containers" and "shipping containers" are often used interchangeably, but there can be differences in their sizes and specifications. Typically, shipping containers are standardized for transport purposes, commonly available in 20-foot and 40-foot lengths.

Nuku""alofa, as the major port of Tonga, supports container, ro-ro, general cargo and tanker traffic. Approximately 200 vessels per annum use the port ranging in size from 4,000 to 50,000 GRT for passenger ships and from 1,500 to 14,000 GRT for merchant ships.
